Students enrolled in MacMurray College's Bachelor of Science in Chemistry program are encouraged to transfer to **Eureka College's** Bachelor of Science in Chemistry program. Students transferring to **Eureka College** under this agreement have the option to graduate from **Eureka College** by completing this program of study including students with fewer than 30 credit hours. Degree Audits showing how MacMurray College credits will transfer into these programs are attached and labeled as the Teach-Out options.

Teach out programs for Elementary Education and Special education are not available due to the Coronavirus pandemic may cause changes to student teaching and Ed TPA requirements. Teach out program is not available for the Philosophy, Political Science and Economics program. Teach out program is not available for Homeland Security program.
