Tuition, Fees, and Expenses

- 1. Tuition for all transferring MacMurray College students into Western Illinois University will be at a rate of \$8,883.00 per year for the 2020-2021 academic year and remain at that rate for the completion of their degree as long as they keep continuously enrolled. The cost guarantee is good for four total years or until degree completion whichever occurs first.
- 2. Fees per year: \$2783.40 for Macomb campus students; \$764.40 for Quad Cities campus students

Scholarship and Grants – Western Illinois University will offer MacMurray College students the following scholarships or grants to apply toward anticipated costs.

- 1. MacMurray College students will be awarded scholarships according to the Fall 2020 Western Illinois University Scholarship guidelines.
- 2. 1. Transfer Commitment Scholarship- This scholarship is for transferring students with 24 earned credit hours or more and a 2.5 Cumulative GPA. This scholarship is renewable for up to 3 years or until the completion of the bachelor's degree whichever occurs first. Students must be continuously enrolled and be in good academic standing each semester for the scholarship to be renewed each year.
- 3. MacMurray College students can apply for additional scholarships for Fall 2020. Access to this information on scholarships and ways to apply are listed at wiu.edu/scholarships.
